Live fire exercises are for the purpose of developing effective coaching techniques, designing courses of fire and developing the ability to recognize and correct shooting deficiencies as orchestrated by the instructors. This course meets the legislative mandate to possess long/short barreled rifles PC33210 and the POST commission regulation 1081 This course also complies with the legislative content and mandates of AB 392, SB 230 and PC835a

This will be an interactive class with student participation being required during all aspects of the training. Throughout the week, there will be individual and group projects to be completed. By the last day, each student will have been required to make presentations and run several range drills.

- Receive average or better evaluations on presentation and communication skills.
- > Pass the final written exam with 80% or better.
